



Antelope Cheer presents its 1st Annual Cheer Competition

This will be a fun new competition where local teams can compete in an inexpensive and friendly atmosphere with some fun twists, first class judges, STUNT match and great sponsored awards

Here are the highlights:

- Traditional awards will be given by division
- Specialty awards to include Judges Favorite Awards
Youth/Jr High & High School – favorite stunt sequence, favorite dance, and favorite pyramid
- Best fan section - who has the most fans in their team color during their teams performance
- Best original team bows - voted on by 1 coach from each team
- Best community service - each program will send a one page description of their charity and what they've done to help and/or bring awareness to it. Judges will read all of them and vote on one to be recognized. A donation from the registrations will be given in the charity's name and recognized to the program during awards.
- Competition Program will have a page dedicated to each program to include a team photo(s), team motto, school spirit goals and any special thank yous.
- A special invitation will be sent to all registered high school programs to send 5 athletes the morning of to learn 2 modified 4-8 count STUNT routines (1 Stunt routine & 1 tumbling routine) and then participate in a round robin competition of STUNT on Saturday before awards. If enough groups participate there will be two groups compete – 1st timers and 2nd years
- Pricing is \$15 per competing participant until November 15th then \$20 thereafter
- \$50 for exhibition teams
- Division rules took into consideration USA and JAMZ divisions with a few exceptions, See rules for full details.
- Free entrance into Fun Divisions for all registered participants to include:
 - Best sideline cheer
 - Best fight song dance
 - Best time-out dance
 - Best Jumper (Jr High & Below/High School)
 - Best Tumbler (Jr High & Below/High School)
- Coaches recognition for all their time and dedication to their programs
